A Minal Legend David John Mortimer Fishlock

25th December 1942 – 13th July 2022



Minal bade farewell to David Fishlock at a moving Service of Celebration and Thanksgiving held at St John the Baptist and afterwards at the Village Hall on 12th August 2022. His family bravely gave emotional tributes and led the large congregation in repeated hymn choruses as was David's way. Emma described her father eloquently saying that he was: *Genuine, warm, generous, a craftsman, an artist, gardener, determined, colourful, a bell ringer, dog lover, mischievous, welcoming, cheerful.* David was born and spent his entire life in Minal. He married Mary in October 1964 and they settled in Minal where she ran the post office while David worked in the building industry, starting his own successful contracting firm. He was always a busy person, with great vision and will to get things done both for his family and the community. He had an incredible talent for handiwork and the village abounds with examples. David loved to share his wonderful memory and knowledge and was always keen to tell stories of people, places and happenings of years gone by. His contribution in word and kind is immeasurable.
