Rob Bailey and Jon Napper on the village hall committee are busy applying for a grant from SSE for equipment to enable us to use the village hall as an emergency muster point with power and supplies and an improved entrance.

People from the Covid 19 volunteers have already come forward with offers to help. We would need people who could distribute sand bags/glow sticks and check on vulnerable people. Other tasks might be helping clear paths or branches. Our local farmers and contractors have volunteered equipment to help with clearing roads if necessary.
