I was interested to read and see photos of the recent floods. I don't think it was the worst in living memory because I can remember our house being flooded out.

We lived in one of four cottages attached to the Blacksmiths shop ( now where Mary Fishlock lives) The front door opened off the road. That year, it must have been in the '40s, we had a lot of snow and when the thaw came, the water came down Greenway and into our houses, being the lowest point, despite a pile of sandbags.

Our "Privys" were down the garden which was completely flooded and level with the river and water meadows, opposite, and we were forbidden to use them. Luckily we were able to use the facilities at the school reached by some steps , still there now, from the road.
